Quarterly Membership Meeting



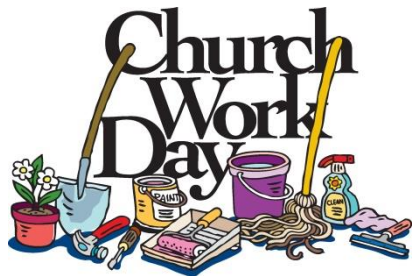
